- 2 positions

Location

Various Suburban Hospitals, Victoria (see detail below)

Background

Cabrini Malvern is a large private hospital with a busy Emergency Department and has a strong emphasis in neurological & musculoskeletal imaging. Victoria House is an imaging centre in Prahran catering to a large outpatient orthopaedic and sports medicine referral base including many elite professional athletes. St Vincent's East Melbourne provides specialist neuro & MSK imaging with an emphasis on MSK and a sub interest in hand, wrist and hip imaging.

Position Description

Two, one year advanced training positions in Magnetic Resonance Imaging are being offered by MIA

Radiology commencing in February 2018. The fellowships are based in the Departments of Medical Imaging at Cabrini Private Hospital Malvern, St Vincent's Private Hospital East Melbourne, John Fawcner Private Hospital Coburg, Frankston Private Hospital and at Victoria House Medical Imaging and Heidelberg Radiology. The positions are structured to provide a mixture of fellowship-type training in MRI (three days per week) and experience working as a general diagnostic radiologist in clinic and private hospital settings (two days per week.) As the position is mixed MRI training and clinical work the successful applicant will need to be qualified and able to work as a diagnostic radiologist in Victoria in 2018.

The training position provides excellent exposure to a wide variety of medical

and surgical pathology in Neurological, Musculoskeletal and Body fields, with an emphasis towards Musculoskeletal MRI. The strength of the position is the broad mix of clinical exposure at the various sites. Supervising radiologists are sub-speciality MR fellowship trained and interpret a wide variety of examinations in the various departments in which they practice.

The training includes exposure to 1.5T and 3T systems including 1.5T and 3T Siemens scanners at Cabrini, a 3T GE scanner at John Fawcner, and 3T Siemens systems at Victoria House, St Vincent's East Melbourne, Heidelberg and Frankston Private.

The fellow will be expected to participate actively in a research project as part of the fellowship.

Location

Victoria House Medical Imaging, Prahran

Background

The musculoskeletal imaging fellowship will focus on MSK MRI at Victoria House and St Vincent's Private Hospital, East Melbourne and diagnostic and interventional MSK ultrasound at Victoria House, although it will also include plain film and CT. Victoria House has a busy diagnostic and therapeutic (ultrasound-guided injections) MSK service with highly experienced radiologists sub-specialised in this area.

Victoria House is an imaging centre in Prahran catering to a large outpatient orthopaedic and sports medicine referral base including many elite professional athletes. The imaging department at St Vincent's Private Hospital in East Melbourne provides specialist neuro & MSK imaging with an

emphasis on MSK and a sub interest in hand, wrist and hip imaging. Both centres are equipped with modern Siemens 3T scanners.

Position Description

A one year advanced training position in Musculoskeletal Imaging is being offered by MIA Radiology commencing in February 2018. The fellowship is based at Victoria House Medical Imaging and St Vincent's Private Hospital in East Melbourne. The position is structured to provide a mixture of fellowship-type training in Musculoskeletal Imaging (three days per week) and experience working as a general diagnostic radiologist in clinic and private hospital settings (two days per week.)


